The reasons for this are as follows: There is no way to know what is coming and when; It can take up to a year to gather enough to send down by courier to the Through the Roof warehouse in Aldershot; Consequently, there is an issue of long term storage; Sometimes, the items donated are not actually usable by the charity.

Please accept our **deep gratitude** for all that you have given over the years. It has been life changing for so many men and women, boys and girls. We recommend that any future items be either: offered back to the NHS, if they issued them and will receive them back (some authorities are now doing that) or offered free to anyone in need - perhaps via church or via a 'free marketplace' website - or taken to one of our local charity shops. Local opticians are now willing to receive unwanted spectacles on behalf of 'sight assistance' charities
