The current law is the only way to safeguard vulnerable people from being pressured to requesting assisted dying.

- 1) The UK government does not change the existing law.

- 3) If palliative care is available to everyone, then nobody will die in pain.
- 4) More Christians to speak up and ask their MPs to represent their views. Consider emailing your MP today to voice your concerns.
